Present: Chief Deputy County Clerk Heidi Nehls, Cindy Skinner, Town of Pine Lake Clerk, and Carla Fletcher, Town of Crescent Chief Election Inspector

Meeting/Canvass was called to order by Heidi Nehls at 9:00 a.m. Procedures utilizing "Suggested Procedures for County Boards of Canvassers" published by Wisconsin Elections Commission, January, 2018, were reviewed and agreed upon. Poll lists with supplemental lists, absentee ballot logs, tally sheets and tapes, and Inspector's Statements will be reviewed. Voter/ballot numbers to be checked for accuracy and compared to election night report. Forms to be checked for signatures and correct completion. Notations will be made below and municipal clerks will be contacted. The Tabular Statement of Votes Cast will be filled in after each municipality is reviewed. Upon completion of the reviews, the election night results will be reconciled for any errors and the Summary Statement of the Board of Canvassers along with the Certification will be completed and signed by the board and will be made a part of these minutes. Entries will be made into WisVote and the printed Summary Statement and Certification will be signed and mailed to the Wisconsin Elections Commission. No Provisional Ballots were issued.

EDR's incomplete at POR section

Unnecessary to get last 4 digits of social security number when DL number is entered

Should've kept a tally sheet for the town

Edge ballots—none were voted, but roll was placed in a large envelope instead of putting into ballot bag. Supplemental list was missing several EDR's. Called Woodruff and spoke to deputy clerk who checked and found that those voters, who all had address changes, had been allowed to sign at their old registration on the poll list instead of entering onto Supplemental List and signature/voter number entered there. Addresses were not changed in poll list. (Provider will need to make sure that that EDR is entered instead of voter in poll list)
