

.ONEIDA COUNTY CIVIL SERVICE COMMISSION MEETING.

April 22, 2013

Members present were: Tim Melms, Bruce Rhode, John Vanney, Bernie Dart and Mary Martin. Present for portions of the meeting were Lt. Dan Hess, Sheriff Grady Hartman and Lt. Lloyd Gauthier. The meeting was called to order by Chair Vanney at 1:03 P.M. The meeting was properly noticed in accordance with the Wisconsin Open Meeting laws.

On a motion by Melms, seconded by Dart, the Commission voted to go into closed session. Voting "aye" on roll call vote were: Melms, Rhode, Vanney, Dart and Martin. MC. The closed session was called pursuant to Sec. (1) © of the Wisconsin stats to evaluate candidates for the position(s) of Detective Sergeant, if and when those positions become available.

Lt. Lloyd Gauthier informed the Commission that 63 people have applied for entry level positions in the Sheriff's Office and following tests and physicals he will prepare an eligibility list for action by the commission. The list is expected to be available by June 15.
