5 6 7 8 9 10 11	WHEREAS, the Planning & Zoning Committee, having considered Ordinance Amendment #1-2008, (copy attached) which was filed August 12, 2008, to amend the Oneida County Zoning and Shoreland Protection Ordinance, and having given notice thereof as provided by law and having held a public hearing thereon September 3, 2008 pursuant to Section 59.69(5), Wisconsin Statutes, and having been informed of the facts pertinent to the changes which are as follows:
12 13	WHEREAS, the Board of Adjustment has been changed from a three (3) to five (5) member Board requiring a majority affirmative vote of three (3) members; and
14 15 16 17	WHEREAS, Chapter 17.04 was clarified to allow the Board of Adjustment to hear and decide appeals involving the Zoning, Floodplain and Private Onsite Wastewater Treatment System Ordinance; and

21 22 23 24 25	WHEREAS, the Planning & Zoning Committee has carefully studied the proposed changes after listening to comments made at the public hearing and recommends approval; and

28 29	NOW THEREFORE, THE ONEIDA COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVIORS DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:
30 31 32 33 34	<u>Section 1:</u> Any existing ordinances, codes, resolutions, or portion thereof in conflict with this ordinance shall be and are hereby repealed as far as any conflict exists. <u>Section 2:</u> This ordinance shall take effect the day after passage and publication as required by law.
35 36 37	<u>Section 3:</u> If any claims, provisions, or portions of this ordinance are adjudged unconstitutional or invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of the ordinance shall not be affected thereby.
38 39 40	<u>Section 4:</u> Additions noted by <u>underline</u> ; deletions noted by <del>strikethrough</del> . Chapter 9 of the Oneida County Zoning & Shoreland Protection Ordinance is amended as follows:

## 60 17.04 POWERS AND DUTIES OF THE BOARD. 61

(1) GENERAL POWERS. The powers and duties of the Board are identified in applicable sections of the state statutes and in the Zoning Ordinance. The Board shall have the following general powers:

(a) To hear and decide appeals where it is alleged there is error in any order, requirement, decision, interpretation or determination made by an administrative official, the Director or the Planning and Zoning Committee in the enforcement of <del>§59.97</del>, §59.69 or §87.30(b) or 145.20 Wis. Stats., or of any part of the Zoning, Floodplain or Private Onsite Wastewater Treatment System Ordinance.
