Resolution offered by Supervisors of the Labor Relations Employee Services Committee.

## Resolved by the Board of Supervisors of Oneida County, Wisconsin:

**WHEREAS**, Resolution #30 – 2010 created a part time (53%) Assistant Tobacco Coordinator/Health Educator position funded 100% by grants and fees, and

**WHEREAS**, the Public Health Department has been awarded a grant that focuses on Performance Management and Quality Improvement with job duties to include Performance Management assessment, planning, implementation and evaluation, and

**WHEREAS**, the Assistant Tobacco Coordinator/Health Educator position will increase by nine hours per week bringing the position to 77%, and

**WHEREAS**, funding for this part time position is 100% funded through grants and public health revenue, and

**WHEREAS**: the Board of Health has reviewed and recommends increasing the part time (53%) Assistant Tobacco Coordinator/Health Educator position to a seventy-seven percent (77%) part time position.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Oneida County Board of Supervisors that effective the day after passage the part time (53%) Assistant Tobacco Coordinator/Health Educator position shall be increased to a seventy-seven percent (77%) part time position.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, by the Oneida County Board of Supervisors that should grant and/or fee funding increase or decrease the hours of the position shall be automatically adjusted accordingly contingent upon approval of committee of jurisdiction and Labor Relations and Employee Services committee.
