8	WHEREAS, the Oneida County Public Works Department preforms work on the			
9	Oneida County system and the State Highway system within the boundaries of Oneida			
10	County; and			
11 12	WHEREAS, work zones pose a known hazard to highway construction and maintenance workers, pedestrians and highway users; and			
13	WHEREAS, if a highway is being constructed, reconstructed, maintained or			
14	repaired, Wisconsin Statutes s. 349.11 (10) authorizes the Highway commissioner or			
15	his/her designee to, for the safety of the highway construction and maintenance workers,			
16	pedestrians and highway users, to post a temporary speed limit less than the speed limit			
17	regularly imposed under their jurisdiction; and			
18	WHEREAS, the Oneida County Public works committee has considered the			
19 20	posting of temporary speed limits; and WHEREAS, the Public Works Committee recommends that the following			
21	language be included in the County code.			
22	NOW, THEREFORE, THE ONEIDA COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS			
23	DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:			
24	Section 1. Any existing ordinances, codes, resolutions, or portions thereof in			
25	conflict with this ordinance shall be and hereby are repealed as far as any conflict exists.			
26 27	Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect the day after passage and publication as required by law.			
28	Section 3. If any claims, provisions or portions of this ordinance are adjudged			
29	unconstitutional or invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the			
30	remainder of this ordinance shall not be affected thereby.			
31	Section 4. Section 7.07 of the General Code of Oneida County, Wisconsin, is			
32	amended as follows [additions noted by underline, deletions noted by strikethrough]:			
33 34	[Note: 7.07/1) (2) Shall remain unchanged]			
34 35	[Note: 7.07(1)-(3) Shall remain unchanged]			
36	(4) If a highway is being constructed, reconstructed, maintained or repaired, temporary			
37	speed limits may be established as set forth in Wis. Statutes. 349.11 (10).

39	(a) The Oneida County Highway Commissioner, or his/her designee, is			
40	authorized, at his/her discretion, to impose mandatory temporary speed limits			
41 42	under the continuing authority of this section and without need of further action by this body.			
43	by this body.			
44	(b) Temporary speed limits shall be in accord with this section and shall be			
45	imposed by the posting of either portable of fixed temporary regulatory speed			
46	limit signs of the face size and design as permanent regulatory speed limit signs,			
47	type R2-1, as described in the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices as			
48 49	adopted by the Wisconsin Department of Transportation.			
49 50	(c) Signs may be posted on any highway under the jurisdiction of this authority			
51	when such highway is being constructed, reconstructed, maintained or repaired,			
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52	but only in the immediate area of such work and of those persons engaged in			
53	preforming such work.

55	(d) Any temporary speed limit imposed in an area where construction,			
56	reconstruction, maintenance or repair is being performed on the shoulder or			
57	within the traveled portion of the roadway, or where the highway construction or			
58	maintenance workers preforming such work area necessary on the shoulder or			
59	what is normally the traveled portion of the roadway, shall be determined by, and			
60	at the discretion of, the Oneida County Highway Commissioner or his/her			
61	designee.

63	(e) No temporary speed limit shall be imposed when construction, reconstruction			
64	or maintenance or repair work is being performed inside the highway right-of-way			
65	but not on the shoulder or the traveled portion of the highway.			
66				
67	(f) Any speed limits imposed under the authority of this section are temporary,			
68	and the signs imposing such limits shall be removed, covered of otherwise			
69	obscured when the highway construction or maintenance workers preforming			
70	construction, reconstruction, maintenance or repairs and their equipment are not			
71	on the shoulders or traveled portion of the highway.

73	(g) The area in which any temporary speed limit imposed shall be terminated by			
74 75	posting a regulatory speed limit sign informing the public of the specific speed			
75 76	limit outside of the area where construction, reconstruction, maintenance or			
76	repair work is being performed.			
77 70	(h) Nothing haroin shall prohibit the Opeida County Highway Commissioner from			
78 79	(h) Nothing herein shall prohibit the Oneida County Highway Commissioner from			
80	posting advisory speed limit signs, of the type W13-1 as described in the manual			
81	of Uniform Traffic Control Devices, in areas of highway construction,			
82	reconstruction, maintenance or repairs suggesting such speed as he or she			
83	deems appropriate to promote the safety of highway construction and maintenance workers, pedestrians and highway users and that such advisory			
84	signs may also be posted in conjunction with the temporary mandatory speed			
85	limit signs, as described and authorized above.
