b. Pets are allowed on the following snowshoe trails: Enterprise Primitive
Snowshoe Winter Silent Sports Trail, Almon Park Wetland Trail, and the Almon Park
Upland Trail.

Section 6. Section 14.15 (3)(a) of the General Code of Oneida County,
Wisconsin, is amended as follows [additions noted by underline, deletions noted by strikethrough]:

No person shall drive operate any bicycle, four-wheel drive vehicle, passenger car, off road vehicle, truck, all-terrain vehicle (ATV'S), utility terrain vehicle, or motorcycle on any
 approved snowmobile trails without the written permission of the land owner or lessee
 Department, except for trail maintenance and/or inspection activities.
