9	WHEREAS, County department heads and staff are routinely called upon to		
10 11	address resolutions and ordinance amendments brought forth by their committee of jurisdiction; and		
11	WHEREAS, given the varying length of County Board meetings it is an		
12	inefficient use of tax-dollars to have department heads and staff at County Board		
14	meetings waiting to address the resolutions and/or ordinance amendments from their		
15	committee of jurisdiction; and		
16	WHEREAS, telephone appearances by department heads and staff at County		
17	Board meetings will allow for department heads and staff to continue to provide services		
18	to county citizens while any resolution or ordinance amendment they may need to		
19	address is not before the County Board; and		
20	WHEREAS, the Buildings and Ground department believes that telephone		
21	appearance by department heads at County Board meeting can be accomplished		
22	effectively and inexpensively.		
23	NOW, THEREFORE, THE ONEIDA COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS		
24	DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:		
25	Section 1. Any existing ordinances, codes, resolutions, or portions thereof in		
26 27	conflict with this ordinance shall be and hereby are repealed as far as any conflict exists.		
27	Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect the day after passage and publication as required by law.		
28 29	Section 3. If any claims, provisions or portions of this ordinance are adjudged		
30	unconstitutional or invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the		
31	remainder of this ordinance shall not be affected thereby.

36	(1) Except where expressly provided by the Wisconsin Statutes or by specific rules		
37	set forth in this chapter, the deliberations of the Board and its boards,		
38	commissions and committees shall be conducted in accordance with procedures		
39	set forth in: A Guide to Parliamentary Procedure for Local Governments in		
40	Wisconsin by Larry E. Larmer. Robert's Rules of Order, newly revised, shall be		
41 42	consulted for any questions of procedure not addressed in the above noted		
42 43	guide. Such guide shall be provided to each supervisory district and shall remain		
43 44	the property of Oneida County. (2) All department head and staff appearances at County Board meetings shall be		
45	<u>conducted by telephone.</u>
