## **RESOLUTION #31-2009**

Resolution offered by Supervisors of the Buildings and Grounds Committee.

## Resolved by the Board of Supervisors of Oneida County, Wisconsin:

**WHEREAS**, Oneida County currently owns two buildings located on River Street in the Town of Crescent for the storage of Emergency Response Equipment, Department on Aging vehicles, Buildings and Grounds Department Property, and Sheriff Department property; and

**WHEREAS**, these buildings were purchased in 1997 as a short-term solution to the lack of available County owned storage space; and

**WHEREAS**, these storage buildings continue to depreciate in value, are energy inefficient, and no longer meet the needs of the County; and

**WHEREAS**, In September of 2008, the Oneida County Central Services Department Long Range Plan identified the need for a potential storage facility for Sheriff / Emergency Management/Courthouse/Department on Aging equipment, and

WHEREAS, The Law Enforcement and Judiciary Committee and Emergency Management Committee have met with the Buildings and Grounds Committee and it is believed that the County has suitable space to accommodate a storage facility adjacent to the Law Enforcement Center, in the City of Rhinelander, and

**WHEREAS,** professional services are needed to evaluate the proposed site of the storage facility, along with the actual storage space and related needs of the various county departments that would be utilizing such a facility.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, The Oneida County Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the Oneida County Buildings and Grounds Committee to hire professional services, for a cost not to exceed \$25,000 to be taken from 59990.711002 Contingency Fund.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, the professional services shall consist of an appraisal of the River Street property, Space Needs Assessment, Site Assessment at the Law Enforcement Center, Architectural Drawings, Cost Estimate for Construction and Projected Operational Costs.
