1 **RESOLUTION #34-2013** 2 3 **GENERAL CODE OF ONEIDA COUNTY, WISCONSIN** 4 ORDINANCE AMENDMENT # 5 6 **Ordinance Amendment offered by the Administration Committee** 7 8 WHEREAS, Ordinance Section 3.09, as written, has an inherent conflict as 9 written; and 10 WHEREAS, Ordinance Section 3.09 requires bidding for equipment, vehicles 11 and non-professional services in manner consistent with Wisconsin State Statute s. 12 59.52(29); and 13 WHEREAS, Wisconsin State Statute s. 59.69(29) does not require that bidding 14 be undertaken for equipment, vehicles or non-professional services; and 15 WHEREAS, the conflict between State Statutes and Oneida County Code 16 causes confusion and delay amongst county staff as they seek to make purchases for 17 Oneida County. NOW, THEREFORE, THE ONEIDA COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS 18 19 DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS: 20 Section 1. Any existing ordinances, codes, resolutions, or portions thereof in 21 conflict with this ordinance shall be and hereby are repealed as far as any conflict exists. 22 Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect the day after passage and publication 23 as required by law. 24 Section 3. If any claims, provisions or portions of this ordinance are adjudged 25 unconstitutional or invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the 26 remainder of this ordinance shall not be affected thereby. 27 Section 4. Section 3.09 of the General Code of Oneida County, Wisconsin, is 28 amended as follows [additions noted by underline, deletions noted by strikethrough]: 29 30 3.09 PURCHASING. 31 32 [Sections 3.09(1) and (2) remain unchanged] 33 34 PURCHASES BY BID. (Amd. #39-2007) (3)35 Unless otherwise permitted by Wisconsin Statutes or this Code, all (a) 36 contracts for public works shall be let pursuant to Wisconsin State 37 Statutes construction, repair, building, furnishing of supplies or materials, 38 equipment, vehicles or nonprofessional services shall be let for bid by 39 contract pursuant to §59.52(29). Wis.
