Any existing ordinances, codes, resolutions, or portions thereof in 18 conflict with this ordinance shall be and hereby are repealed as far as any conflict exists. 19 Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect the day after passage and publication 20 as required by law. 21 Section 3. If any claims, provisions or portions of this ordinance are adjudged 22 unconstitutional or invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the 23 remainder of this ordinance shall not be affected thereby. 24 Section 4. Section 3.12(2) of the General Code of Oneida County, Wisconsin, is 25 amended as follows [additions noted by underline, deletions noted by strikethrough]: 26 27 3.12 FINANCIAL POLICIES AND PROCEDURES. (Am. Res. #117-2008) 28 (1) All deposits of public funds shall be made daily on each business day only at one of the 29 public depositories listed on the annual resolution adopted by the County Board at its annual 30 meeting. 31 (2) The County Treasurer shall have the authority to make all payments to the County which are 32 short \$2 5 or less. The Treasurer shall have the authority to voucher from the General Fund 33 funds needed to accomplish the payment of these incidental shortages.
