0	WHEREAS, the Clerk of Circuit Courts is a constitutional officer elected at large by the people of Oneida County; and
2 3 4 5 6	WHEREAS, Oneida County holds all elected officials to the highest moral ethical and legal standards of conduct while in office, whether elected or appointed; and
6 7 8 9	WHEREAS, in addition to the moral, ethical and legal implications, the conduct complained of implicates possible blood-borne pathogen issues and risk management requires all employees to be aware of and follow all measures that reduce the risk of transmission and the spread of blood-borne pathogens; and
21 22 23 24 25 26 27	WHEREAS, this behavior if conducted by a County employee would not have been tolerated and would have resulted in immediate termination of employment; and
26 27 28 29	WHEREAS, Pursuant to Section 17.09 (2), Wis. Stats., removal from office is the only disciplinary action that may be taken against a Clerk of Circuit Court and the Oneida County Clerk of Circuit Court may only be removed by a majority of the Oneida County Circuit Court judges, for cause; and
31 32 33	WHEREAS, the Oneida County Board of Supervisors has no authority to remove or otherwise discipline the Clerk of Circuit Court; and
34 35 36 37 38	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Oneida County Board of Supervisors does hereby go on record stating that the appropriate remedy for the Clerk of Circuit Court's conduct is termination and demands her immediate resignation from office.
