## 1 RESOLUTION #53-2010/GENERAL CODE/OA 2 3 **GENERAL CODE OF ONEIDA COUNTY, WISCONSIN** 4 ORDINANCE AMENDMENT 5 6 Ordinance Amendment offered by Supervisors of the Resolutions & 7 Ordinances/Legislative Committee. 8 9 Whereas, The Oneida County Board of Supervisors has adopted "A Guide to 10 Parliamentary Procedure for Local Governments in Wisconsin" by Larry Larmer as its official Rule of Order, and 11 12 Whereas, Larmer suggests that rules of procedure specific to their own situation 13 should be adopted by local governments, and 14 Whereas, the Resolutions & Ordinances/legislative committee is suggesting 15 adopting the following rule. NOW, THEREFORE, THE ONEIDA COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS 16 17 **DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:** 18 Section 1. Any existing ordinances, codes, resolutions, or portions thereof in 19 conflict with this ordinance shall be and hereby are repealed as far as any conflict exists. 20 Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect the day after passage and publication 21 as required by law. 22 Section 3. If any claims, provisions or portions of this ordinance are adjudged 23 unconstitutional or invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the 24 remainder of this ordinance shall not be affected thereby. 25 Section 4. Section 3.10(7) of the General Code of Oneida County, Wisconsin, is 26 amended as follows [additions noted by underline, deletions noted by strikethrough]: 27 28 3.10 REIMBURSEMENT FOR EXPENSES. 29 30 Sections (1) through (6) remain unchanged. 31 32 (7) PROCEDURES FOR PER DIEM AND EXPENSE PAYMENT. 33 Per Diem. (Am. #102-2007) Qualified persons who incur per diem expenses shall 34 submit vouchers to the Finance Department. The Finance Department shall pay the per 35 diem vouchers submitted after confirming the business has been authorized by a 36 committee or the Board. Any such qualified person who receives per diem expenses or 37 other compensation from another entity will not be entitled to receive a per diem from the 38 county.
