Resolved by the Board of Supervisors of Oneida County, Wisconsin:

WHEREAS, the Human Services Work Group Committee has been analyzing the needs of Oneida County in regard to Family Care Services; and

WHEREAS, the Human Services Work Group Committee recommends forming a Family Care Committee to review, study and recommend the appropriate implementation of a Managed Care Organization/Care Management Organization (MCO/CMO) and Aging and Disability Resource Center (ADRC) in Oneida County. Members of the committee shall be as follows: one County Board member or designee, Social Services Director or designee, Aging Director or designee, and the 51 Board Director or designee, and

WHEREAS, the Human Services Work Group Committee recommends the Family Care Committee be created for a term of twenty four months, and

WHEREAS, the Family Care Committee shall invite Vilas, Forest, Florence, Taylor and Lincoln counties and Tribes within those counties, to participate in the planning consortium.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Oneida County Board of Supervisors does create a Family Care Committee as described above, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Oneida County Board of Supervisors creates a Family Care Committee for twenty-four months.
