RESOLUTION # 72-2010 **REZONE PETITION #5-2010**

Resolution offered by Supervisors of the Planning and Zoning Committee.

Resolved by the Board of Supervisors of Oneida County, Wisconsin:

WHEREAS, the Planning & Zoning Committee, having considered Petition #5-2010, as amended, (copy attached) which was filed June 8, 2010 and amended on July 13, 2010 (copy attached) to amend the Master Zoning District Document and the Oneida County Official Zoning District Boundary Map, and having given notice thereof as provided by law and having held a public hearing thereon August 4, 2010 pursuant to Section 59.69(5), Wisconsin Statutes, and having been informed of the facts pertinent to the changes which are as follows:

15 To rezone land from District #5, Recreational to District #2, Single Family Residential for 16 property described as part of Gov't Lot 1, Section 9, T39N, R5E, Town of Minocqua identified as 17 PIN's MI 1692-2, MI 1692-3, MI 1692-4, MI 1692-5, MI 1692-6, MI 1692-7 and MI 1692-1 now 18 identified as MI 7443 – 7461, which is Squirrel Lake Resort Condominiums. 19 20

And being duly advised of the wishes of the people in the area affected as follows:

22 23 The Squirrel Lake Owners Association and several affected landowners sought the change. After the original rezoning request submittal, the petitioner amended the request to 24 25 exclude one parcel (MI 1692). Most of the land surrounding Squirrel Lake is already zoned single family and the Squirrel Lake Owners Association wishes to preserve the single family 26 27 residential characteristics they presently enjoy. During the public hearing one landowner objected to his land being rezoned. The Planning and Zoning Committee, after careful 28 consideration, further amended the rezoning to exclude the objecting landowner and another 29 parcel of land from this request (MI 1692-4, MI 1692-6 and MI 1692-7). This modification then 30 excluded all land north of the town road. 31

32 33 The Town of Minocqua approved the request, as originally amended, in writing (copy attached). The Minocqua Town Chairman appeared at the public hearing and indicated the Town 34 Continues to support this request. Adjoining landowners were provided with a written notice of 35 the change. The Planning and Zoning Committee has reviewed the general standards as 36 specified in Section 9.86F of the Oneida County Zoning and Shoreland Protection Ordinance 37 and concluded that the standards have been met. The Planning & Zoning Committee 38 unanimously recommends passage as amended. 39

40 NOW THEREFORE, THE ONEIDA COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS DOES ORDAINS 41 AS FOLLOWS: Petition #5-2010.

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43 Any existing ordinances, codes, resolutions, or portion thereof in conflict with this Section 1: 44 ordinance shall be and are hereby repealed as far as any conflict exists.

- 45 Section 2: The ordinance shall take effect the day after passage and publication as required 46 by law.
- 47 Section 3: If any claims, provisions, or portions of this ordinance are adjudged
- 48 unconstitutional or invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of the ordinance 49 shall not be affected thereby.
- 50 Section 4: Rezone Petition #5-2010 is hereby adopted amending the Master Zoning District
- 51 Document and the Oneida County Official Zoning District Boundary Map, by changing the
