1 **RESOLUTION #74-2012** 2 3 **GENERAL CODE OF ONEIDA COUNTY, WISCONSIN** 4 ORDINANCE AMENDMENT # 5 6 Ordinance Amendment offered by Supervisor Dave Hintz 7 8 WHEREAS, current rules of procedure for the Oneida County Board meetings 9 provide that each resolution/ordinance amendment be read in its entirety absent a 10 motion to suspend the reading; and 11 WHEREAS, the current procedure noted above is time consuming and 12 inefficient: and 13 WHEREAS, it would be more efficient to read just the resolution/ordinance 14 amendment number and the sponsoring supervisor or committee before proceeding to 15 debate on that resolution/ordinance amendment; and 16 WHEREAS, the Administration Committee feels that if a supervisor wishes to 17 have a resolution/ordinance amendment read in its entirety the supervisor needs only to 18 make that request to the County Board Chairman and the resolution/ordinance 19 amendment shall be read in its entirety. 20 NOW, THEREFORE, THE ONEIDA COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS 21 DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS: 22 Section 1. Any existing ordinances, codes, resolutions, or portions thereof in 23 conflict with this ordinance shall be and hereby are repealed as far as any conflict exists. 24 Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect the day after passage and publication 25 as required by law. 26 Section 3. If any claims, provisions or portions of this ordinance are adjudged 27 unconstitutional or invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the 28 remainder of this ordinance shall not be affected thereby. 29 Section 4. Section 2.04 of the General Code of Oneida County, Wisconsin, is 30 amended as follows [additions noted by underline, deletions noted by strikethrough]: 31 32 2.04 RULE 4: PETITIONS, ETC., TO BE READ AND ENDORSED. 33 34 All petitions, remonstrances, reports, accounts, resolutions and ordinances shall (1) 35 have endorsed thereon the name of the person introducing or submitting the 36 same. 37 38 By motion of a member unanimously passed by voice vote of the Board, such (2) 39 reading of the entire document or specific portions thereof may be waived. The 40 Clerk shall read the resolution number and the sponsor of the resolution prior to 41 debate by the County Board.
