1 Resolution #75-2016 2 3 **GENERAL CODE OF ONEIDA COUNTY, WISCONSIN** 4 ORDINANCE AMENDMENT # 5 6 Ordinance Amendment offered by the Administration Committee 7 8 WHEREAS, the Oneida County Public Records policy is set forth in the Oneida 9 County Code in section 1.30; and 10 WHEREAS, various Oneida County departments have indicated that they are 11 rapidly running out of space for storage of paper records; and 12 WHEREAS, those same departments have requested the authority to scan and 13 electronically store documents in order to save storage space; and 14 WHEREAS. Wisconsin State Statutes section 59.52(14) allows for the storage of 15 records in an electronic format with County Board authorization; and 16 WHEREAS, a records custodian that elects to store records electronically shall 17 continue to follow all records retention schedules & the requirements of Wis. Stat. s. 18 59.52(14). 19 NOW, THEREFORE, THE ONEIDA COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS 20 DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS: 21 Section 1. Any existing ordinances, codes, resolutions, or portions thereof in 22 conflict with this ordinance shall be and hereby are repealed as far as any conflict exists. 23 Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect the day after passage and publication 24 as required by law. 25 Section 3. If any claims, provisions or portions of this ordinance are adjudged 26 unconstitutional or invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the 27 remainder of this ordinance shall not be affected thereby. 28 Section 4. Section 1.30 of the General Code of Oneida County, Wisconsin, is 29 amended as follows [additions noted by underline, deletions noted by strikethrough]: 30 31 [Ordinance Sections 1.30(1)-(7) shall remain unchanged] 32 33 (8) PRESERVATION THROUGH MICROFILM OR OPTICAL DISK/ELECTRONIC 34 STORAGE. The Oneida County Boards authorizes Any County officer or the director of 35 any department or division of County government to may, subject to the approval of the 36 County Board, keep and preserve public records in his their possession by means of 37 microfilm, or other photographic reproduction or optical disc/electronic storage method. 38 Such records shall meet the standards for photographic reproduction set forth in 39 §16.61(7)(a) and (b), Wis. Stats., and/or the standards set forth in 59.52.(14) Wis. 40 Stats. for optical disk/electronic storage and shall be considered original records for 41 all purposes.
