8	Whereas, Chapter 18, titled 'County Real Estate Transactions' was reviewed by			
9	the Land Records Committee and the Committee recommends that changes be made to			
10	various parts of the ordinance for improved administration of the ordinance.			
11	NOW, THEREFORE, THE ONEIDA COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS			
12	DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:			
13 14	Section 1. Any existing ordinances, codes, resolutions, or portions thereof in conflict with this ordinance shall be and hereby are repealed as far as any conflict exists.			
15	Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect the day after passage and publication			
16	as required by law.			
17	Section 3. If any claims, provisions or portions of this ordinance are adjudged			
18	unconstitutional or invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the			
19	remainder of this ordinance shall not be affected thereby.			
20	Section 4. The following Sections of Chapter 18 of the General Code of Oneida			
21	County, Wisconsin, is amended as follows [additions noted by underline, deletions noted			
22	by strikethrough]:			
23 24	18.02 DELEGATION OF COUNTY REAL ESTATE TRANSACTIONS.			
25	(1) ADMINISTRATION. (Am. #113-2007) The LAND RECORDS COMMITTEE			
26	shall administer this Chapter and shall be referred to in this Chapter as the "Committee."			
27	(2) POWERS AND DUTIES. Such Committee shall:			
28	(a) Administer the County real estate as described in §18.01 of this Chapter and in			
29	accordance with Ch. 75, Wis. Stats including, but not necessarily limited to, secs. 75.35,			
30	75.36, and 75.69. and 59.52.			
31	(b) Determine the value of any real estate before the County sells it in the following			
32	manner:			
33	(1) For real estate acquired through tax deed or in rem tax foreclosure judgment, the			
34	values to be used for minimum bid amounts at the first advertised sale of those properties			
35	with a last known estimated fair market value of \$25,000 or greater as listed in the tax			
36	roll, shall be offered for no less than the value as determined by the Committee last			
37	known fair market value as listed in the tax roll or at the discretion of the Committee, for			
38	the value determined by an appraisal conducted by a certified appraiser. If the value set			
39	by the Committee is less than the fair market value, it shall prepare a written statement,			
40	available for public inspection that explains the reasons for setting the value lower.			
41	Remainder of section is unchanged.

43	18.04 REAL ESTATE SALES OF TAX DEED OR IN REM TAX FORECLOSURE			
44	PROPERTIES.			
45	18.04 (1) through (6) remain unchanged.			
46	(7) At least 3 weeks prior to the sale date the clerk of the municipality in which the			
47	real estate being offered for sale is located shall be notified per §75.69(4), Wis. Stats.			

With this notification the County will request the municipality inform the County of any

49	concerns the municipality may have regarding the sale. The municipality may consider				
50	such items as:				
51	(a) Unwarranted increases in governmental expenses.				
52	(b) Type of highway and other reservations desirable.				
53	(c) Other factors which should be considered in the decision of the County.				
54	(d) Interest in acquiring the real estate for the municipalities use, however the Count				
55	reserves the right to include a reversionary clause if the property is no longer needed for				
56	their use.				
57	(e) If the municipality expresses interest in the property, the Committee may				
58	negotiate the price that it may charge the municipality for the property to recover costs				
59	associated with the property incurred by the County or recommend to the County Board				
60	that it be deeded at no charge.				
61	Remainder of section remains unchanged.
