8	WHEREAS, many lakes and flowages in Oneida County are created by dams, whether
9	located within the boundaries of the county or outside; and
10	WHEREAS, threats to those dams was raised as an issue in various district races in the
11	2014 Oneida County Board Supervisor election; and
12	WHEREAS, lakes and flowages formed by those dams create recreational opportunities
13	within the county that help to bring tourism revenue into the county; and
14	WHEREAS, many businesses within the county depend on those tourism revenues; and
15	WHEREAS, the county treasury benefits from sales tax revenue generated by that
16	tourism; and
17	WHEREAS, tourism accounts for the equivalent of approximately 2,000 full-time jobs
18	which greatly benefit the economy of the county; and
19	WHEREAS, many residential properties are also located along the shores of those lakes
20 21	and flowages; and
$\frac{21}{22}$	WHEREAS, those residential properties are prime locations and are assessed at higher levels than are non-waterfront properties; and
22	WHEREAS, the property tax revenue generated by those waterfront properties are

25	WHEREAS, at least two area paper mills are located on the shores of flowages because

28	that benefit the local economy; and
29	WHEREAS, removal of those dams would have detrimental and far reaching

31 32	meets its statutory obligations to the residents of the county; and to the general welfare of the
32	county, its residents and its taxpayers.
33	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Oneida County Board of Supervisors
34	that an ad hoc Committee to determine the threat(s) to those dams, the source of the threat(s)
35	and the appropriate action to mitigate the threat(s) shall be created; and

37	county board supervisors, 1 each from the following committees: Forestry, Land and Outdoor
