9	Whereas, County Code section 6.03(1) states in part: "it is necessary to provide
10	for emergency interim officers who can exercise the powers and discharge the duties of
11	the County Board Chair", and
12	Whereas, the code continues at section 2.01(4): "At the time of the election of
13	the Chairperson of the Board, the Board shall also elect a Vice-Chairperson for a term of
14	two years", and
15	Whereas, the Resolutions and Ordinances/Legislative Committee recommends
16	amending the code and adding a Second Vice-Chair.
17 18	NOW, THEREFORE, THE ONEIDA COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
18	DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:
20	Section 1. Any existing ordinances, codes, resolutions, or portions thereof in
21	conflict with this ordinance shall be and hereby are repealed as far as any conflict exists.
22	Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect on April 20, 2010.
23	Section 3. If any claims, provisions or portions of this ordinance are adjudged
24	unconstitutional or invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the
25	remainder of this ordinance shall not be affected thereby.
26	Section 4. Section 2.01(4) of the General Code of Oneida County, Wisconsin, is
27	amended as follows [additions noted by underline, deletions noted by strikethrough]:
28 29	RULES OF PROCEDURE
29 30	2.01 RULE 1: GOVERNING BODY.
31	Sections (1),(2) and (3) remain unchanged.
32	(4) VICE-CHAIRPERSON and SECOND VICE-CHAIRPERSON. At the time of the
33	election of the Chairperson of the Board, the Board shall also elect a Vice-Chairperson
34	and Second Vice-Chairperson (hereafter referred to as Vice-Chair and Second Vice-
35	Chair) for a term of 2 years. The Vice-Chair shall perform the duties of the Chair when
36	she/he is absent or disabled or when the Chair wishes temporarily to vacate the chair. In
37	case of the absence of both the Chair and the Vice-Chair, the Second Vice-Chair shall
38	perform the duties of the Chair. In case of the absence of the Chair, Vice-Chair or
39 40	Second Vice-Chair for any meeting, the members present shall choose another member
40 41	to be the temporary chair. (5) PROCEDURE FOR SELECTION OF CHAIR AND_,VICE-CHAIR and SECOND
42	<u>VICE-CHAIR</u> . The Chair, and Vice-Chair and Second Vice-Chair shall be selected at the
43	first meeting after each regular election at which members are elected for full terms
44	according to the following procedure:
45	(a) Temporary Chair. The County Clerk shall serve as temporary chair until after the
46	Chair is elected.
47	(b) Nominations. Nominations from the members shall be accepted for the position
48	of Chair. No member may nominate more than one person. After motion to close
49	nominations, which requires a 2/3 vote, election of the Chair shall take place as provided
50	below. After election of the Chair, the procedure shall be repeated for the position of
51	Vice-Chair and repeated again for the position of Second Vice-Chair.
