NOW. THEREFORE, THE ONEIDA COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS 15 16 **DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:** 17 Section 1. Any existing ordinances, codes, resolutions, or portions thereof in 18 conflict with this ordinance shall be and hereby are repealed as far as any conflict exists. 19 Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect the day after passage and publication 20 as required by law. 21 Section 3. If any claims, provisions or portions of this ordinance are adjudged 22 unconstitutional or invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the 23 remainder of this ordinance shall not be affected thereby. 24 Section 4. Section 2.16 of the General Code of Oneida County, Wisconsin, is 25 amended as follows [additions noted by underline, deletions noted by strikethrough]: 26 27 2.16 RULE 16: MEETINGS OF THE BOARD AND COMMITTEES 28 29 Sections (1) and (2) remain unchanged. 30 31 BOARD MEETINGS AT COUNTY LOCATIONS OTHER THAN COURTHOUSE. 32 The Board may schedule regular meetings at locations in the County other than the 33 Courthouse if it is determined that a change of location would be in the best interest of 34 the Board. the best interests of the County would be served due to the existence of 35 unusual conditions or reasons. A proposed change of location shall be approved not less 36 than 30 days before the scheduled meeting date.
