RESOLUTION #61-2013

Resolution offered by the Land Records Committee.

Resolved by the Board of Supervisors of Oneida County, Wisconsin:

WHEREAS, Oneida County retained ownership of a 100 foot strip of land on each side of the centerline of existing highways crossing the N ½ of the Northeast ¼ - Northwest ¼, as described in Volume 58 of Deeds, Page 109, recorded April 14th, 1944, and a strip of land 2 rods wide on each side of the centerline crossing the Northwest ¼ - Northwest ¼, described in Volume 170 Page 34, recorded May 19th, 1948, all being in Section 20, Township 37 North, Range 11 East, Town of Piehl; and

WHEREAS, the Wisconsin Department of Transportation local road inventory plats indicate a town road existed within the confines of the aforementioned strip of County owned land from 1930 until 1986, when the Town of Piehl stopped maintaining the road; and

WHEREAS, during the 56 year period that the aforementioned town road formally existed, known today as Stecker RD, the roads primary use developed into and continues to be the only means of ingress and egress to and from several privately owned parcels of adjacent land; and

WHEREAS, this situation has raised questions regarding responsibility for future road maintenance expenses, liability, and ingress/egress rights; and

WHEREAS, in 2005 the Town of Piehl offered to assume ownership of the aforementioned County owned land and work out any access and maintenance issues pertaining to said property; and

WHEREAS, a resolution was prepared in 2005 for the Forestry, Land, & Outdoor Recreation Committee and reviewed and signed by Corporation Counsel Heath to transfer such lands, however, for unknown reasons it did not get forwarded to the County Board; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Piehl has recently contacted the County looking for the deed to the property; so

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Oneida County Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes and directs the County Clerk to issue a quit claim deed to the Town of Piehl for the lands described in Exhibit A below.
