Any existing ordinances, codes, resolutions, or portions thereof in 16 conflict with this ordinance shall be and hereby are repealed as far as any conflict exists. 17 Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect the day after passage and publication 18 as required by law. 19 Section 3. If any claims, provisions or portions of this ordinance are adjudged 20 unconstitutional or invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the 21 remainder of this ordinance shall not be affected thereby. 22 Section 4. (Am. #50-2004) 26 REGISTER OF DEEDS RECORDING FEES. (1) 27 The fee for recording certificate and preparing and mailing documents 28 shall be in accordance with under §59.43, Wis. Stats., shall be \$11. 29 For each additional page required for instruments submitted for recording <del>(b)</del> 30 under § 59.43, Wis.
