RESOLUTION # 32-2012

Resolution offered by the Forestry, Land, & Outdoor Recreation Committee.

Resolved by the Board of Supervisors of Oneida County, Wisconsin:

WHEREAS, the sale of utility terrain vehicles (UTVs), has grown steadily in the State of Wisconsin since 2008; and

WHEREAS, the number of UTVs purchased and registered annually in the State of Wisconsin is expected to increase into the foreseeable future; and

WHEREAS, the increasing number of UTVs in the State of Wisconsin has created an increasing demand for a place to ride these vehicles; and

WHEREAS, to address the increasing public demand for places to ride UTVs, the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources (WDNR) developed the "Utility Terrain Vehicle Pilot Program"; and

WHEREAS, the WDNR, in consultation with the Department of Transportation, shall administer the UTV Pilot Program to evaluate the effects of UTV use on existing All-Terrain Vehicle (ATV) trails and roadways open to said vehicles; and

WHEREAS, the results of the above-described evaluation will be used to determine if it is appropriate and feasible to expand the UTV Pilot Program into a permanent UTV program; and

WHEREAS, in order to regulate the use of UTVs during the pilot program a UTV will be considered the same as an ATV, therefore all state regulations and county ordinances that apply to ATV use will also apply to UTV use; and

WHEREAS, the UTV pilot program will end on June 30, 2012 and the County may withdraw from the pilot program prior to the end of the program by adopting a resolution to that effect; and

WHEREAS, the passage of this resolution will permit operation of UTVs on town and village roads that are currently open to ATV use unless the town or village passes a resolution prohibiting the use of UTVs on said roads; and

WHEREAS, the passage of this resolution does not permit operation of UTVs on Oneida County ATV trails, as said trails require modifications to safely accommodate larger UTVs;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Oneida County Board of Supervisors approves allowing UTVs to operate on all municipal ATV road routes, unless a municipality prohibits such operation by resolution.
