Individual Tags


- Each person responding in a department vehicle attaches an Individual Tag to each Apparatus Tag.
 - When on-scene report to command, turn an Individual Tag to be assigned to a crew.
 - If reassigned to another crew take your Individual Tag with you and give it to the new crew.
 - You must retrieve all tags when incident is over.

Apparatus Tags




- All riders attach an Individual Tag to each Apparatus Tag.
- Officer-Lead Person attaches their Individual Tag on top position of the Apparatus Tag.
- Vehicle Operator should place his/her Individual Tag upside-down on the bottom of the Apparatus Tag.
- Red Apparatus Tag stays in the Vehicle and the White Apparatus Tag is given to Command or a Staging Officer.

Resource Management Card



- This card identifies the vehicle along with its key equipment.
- This card stays in the vehicle unless it responds to a call where staging is established.
- At staging the Resource Management Card and the White Apparatus Tags are given to the Staging Officer.
- When given an assignment outside of staging or when released from staging, the Resource Management Card and Apparatus Tags are given back.

Incident Command Board

- Incident Command Board is used as a tactical sheet for the incident.
- Command-Staging attaches Apparatus Tags to track resources.
- Command-Staging uses Function/Sector Tags to organize assignments.
- Team Tags can be added as needed to represent additional personnel.
