Use the following definitions when determining the extent of structural damage:

## Tornado/Severe Thunder Storm (Standard Home/Business)

- Destroyed:** (Not Livable) Foundation only remains, or two or more walls are destroyed, or the roof is substantially damaged.
- Major:** (Not Livable) Two walls and roof substantially damaged.
- Minor:** (Not Livable) One wall and a section of roof damaged.
- Affected:** (Livable) Intermittent shingle damage.

## Tornado/Severe Thunderstorm (Mobile Homes)

- Destroyed:** (Not Livable) Frame twisted, or knocked off piers.
- Major:** (Not Livable) Wall and roof damage, or shifted on piers.
- Minor:** (Not Livable) Utility connections broken, or foundation shifted.
- Affected:** (Livable) Minor indentations to roof and siding.

## Flood Event (Standard Home/Business)

- Destroyed:** (Not Livable) Not economically repairable, or pushed off the foundation.
- Major:** (Not Livable) Two or more feet of water on the 1st floor (homes with no basement) or structural damage-collapsed basement walls.
- Minor:** (Not Livable) Less than two feet of water on the 1st floor (homes with no basement) or one to eight feet of water in the basement.
- Affected:** (Livable) Less than one foot of water in the basement, or minor access problem.

## Flood Event (Mobile Homes)

- Destroyed:** (Not Livable) Water above floor level, or unit swept from foundation.
- Major:** (Not Livable) Water soaked bottom board, or shifted on piers.
- Minor:** (Not Livable) Utilities flooded, or piers shifted washed out.
- Affected:** (Livable) Access problems, no water touched the unit.
