
**TOUR THE SITE OF THE LYNNE METALLIC ORE DEPOSIT**—A brief on-site tour / inspection of the Lynne Metallic Ore Deposit site was conducted. Upon conclusion of the Lynne Mineral site tour / inspection, a motion was made by Sorensen, seconded by Pence, that the FLRC recess to travel to Ladysmith, WI and that no county business would be discussed during said trip and the committee would go back into session at 12:30 p.m. at the Ladysmith City Hall. All in favor. Motion carried

At 12:30 p.m. Mott moved to return to session. All aye, motion carried. A presentation was then given by Al Christianson, Ladysmith City Coordinator, regarding the history and processes that Rusk County, the City of Ladysmith, and the Town of Grant had with the Flambeau Mine. Overall Mr. Christianson relayed that Rusk County, the City of Ladysmith, and the Town of Grant viewed the Flambeau Mine as having a positive impact on their community, and that they would consider future mining favorably in their areas of jurisdiction.
