HAZMAT TEAM REPORT

Technician, Operation and Support members were cited. Rhinelander Fire has a higher ratio of members on the Team verses the number of volunteer members. There are three HazMat probationary members: Boos, Feaker and Smiley. At the next LEPC Meeting, probationary members (if there are no concerns) will be placed on the team as full-time members.

There was one HazMat call/response to Lincoln Co. involving a dump truck, there were three HazMat trainings including one training in Land O'Lakes and, the State HazMat Contract has been renewed from 2017-2019.

There was discussion if contracted counties inventoried their supplies. The Emergency Management Director explained Oneida does not own supplies outside of our county, contracted counties have purchased supplies for their county.

WI Hazmat Online Planning & Reporting System/Fall Upgrade:

WI HazMat Online Planning & Reporting System (WHOPRS) will be upgraded incorporating EPA's twenty-four chemical hazard category codes/physical & health hazard section when reporting chemicals and, incorporate OSHA elements mandating

that all chemical manufacturers include the chemical hazard category codes on Safety Data Sheets (SDS). The State scheduled the update in Fall 2017 and recommends facilities Amend their Tier II Reports so information can be carried forward into 2018 rather than waiting to do so in 2018 as, all reporting facilities in the State will be required to file according to the updated requirements. The State EPCRA Division emailed all reporting facilities in the State the information. The Emergency Management Program Assistant emailed planning facilities a reminder to aid in filing Amended Tier II reports.

2017 Computer/HazMat Equipment Grant:

The Emergency Management Office received grant approval and purchased equipment were cited. Contracted counties, and Oneida Co., purchases equipment for the HazMat Team.

Planning/Reporting Facility Report:

An Emergency Planning and Community Right-to-Know Act (EPCRA) presentation explaining the program (planning facilities, reporting facilities, railroad routes, etc.) was conducted.
