Resolved by the Board of Supervisors of Oneida County , Wisconsin 5 6 Whereas Crandon Mining Company's plan to establish mining operations in Forest County along with the construction of a water 7 discharge pipeline across Oneida County have the potential for both 8 environmental and socio-economic consequences for Oneida County, 9 10 11 identification and understanding Whereas, of environmental and socio-economic impacts, along with a knowledge of 12 the concerns of the public, is an important foundation for a sound 13 decision making process regarding these matters, and the potential 14 future developement of a local agreement, and 15 Whereas, a study of the County's existing and predicted environmental and socio-economic conditions shall provide useful 16 17 18 information for long range comprehensive planning whether or not the Crandon Mine becomes a reality, and 19 Whereas, the Mining Oversite and Local Impact Committee has 20 developed specifications for the types of information wanted, and requested and received proposals from various firms for the gathering, analysis, and summary of this information, and 21 22 23 Whereas, the process has resulted in the determination that the combined proposal of the firms RUST Environmental and 24 25 Infrastructure (RUST) and Planning Information Corporation (PIC) in 26 a contract amount of \$68,518.00, is the most advantageous to Oneida 27 28 County, and 29 30 Whereas, the Mining Oversite and Local Impact Committee has \$14,900 in funds available and shall attempt to secure additional funds from the State of Wisconsin Mining Investment and Local Impact Fund 31 32 Board along with any other available sources, and 33 Whereas, the Mining Oversite and Local Impact Committee feels that 34 the socio-economic, environmental, and public input information 35 gathering should commence concurrently and as soon as possible, so 36 Therefore be it resolved that the Oneida County Board of 37 Supervisors hereby authorize the Mining Oversite and Local Impact 38 Committee to enter into agreement with RUST/PIC for the above mentioned impact study and to authorize transfer of \$53,618.00, from the general fund to the Mining Committee budget for this 39 40 41 purpose, with the understanding that outside funding sources will 42 be aggressively sought to reimburse as many of these costs as 43 possible. 44 ماه r
