Discuss combination of parcels CA 360-2 and CA 360-3 for property described as Section 24, T37N, R6E, Town of Cassian.

Mr. Jennrich stated that this is a request to combine two parcels by way of metes and bounds description rather than a certified survey map.

Motion by Scott Holewinski, second by Mike Timmons to approve the combination of parcels as requested. With all members present voting "aye", the motion carried.

The committee will be discussing scheduling a hearing to amend, suspend, or revoke Administrative Review Permit #13-014 pursuant to 9.82(d) of the Oneida County Zoning and Shoreland Protection Ordinance. Property located at 7510 Birch Tree Drive, further described as Lot 8, Farris-Martin-Schauder Subdivision, Section 32, T39N, R9E, PIN SU 1624, Town of Sugar Camp, Oneida County.

Mr. Jennrich stated that the owners of this property were issued an Administrative Review Permit, to rent the home on a weekly basis, in 2013. In 2015 there were complaints received by the Town of Sugar Camp. Mr. Jennrich sent the owners a letter regarding the complaints.

Motion by Billy Fried, second by Dave Hintz to respond to the Town of Sugar Camp based on Corporation Counsel's legal advice that the Planning and Development committee cannot hear cases regarding violations of Deed Restrictions and complaints concerning violations of Administrative Review Permits should be directed to Karl Jennrich, Zoning Director; and not proceed with any further action at this time. There is an approved permit for the property and the General Standards cannot be reviewed again. The Town of Sugar Camp will inform the Town of the procedures and future permits will be handled in a different fashion. On roll call vote: Aye: 4 Abstain: 1. The motion carried.

Discuss restrictive covenants and deed restrictions in relation to General Zoning/Shoreland Zoning permit requirements.
