### **CONDUCT PUBLIC HEARING ON THE FOLLOWING:**

<u>Ordinance Amendment #4-2011</u>, authored by the Planning and Zoning to amend Section 9.26, Business B-1 and B-2 (District 6 and 7) of the Oneida County Zoning and Shoreland Protection Ordinance to <u>allow churches</u>, <u>schools</u>, <u>libraries</u>, <u>community buildings and museums as an administrative use.</u> Ordinance Amendment #4-2011 is contained in the file and is part of today's record and attached to the meeting minutes.

Karl Jennrich, Zoning Director, read the notice of public hearing for Ordinance Amendment #4-2011, authored by the Planning and Zoning to amend Section 9.26, Business B-1 and B-2 (District 6 and 7) of the Oneida County Zoning and Shoreland

Protection Ordinance to allow churches, schools, libraries, community buildings and museums as an administrative use. The notice was published in the Northwoods River News on May 24 & 31, 2011. The proof of publication is contained in the file. The notice was posted on the Oneida County Courthouse bulletin board on May 20, 2011. The mailing list was also read into the record.

• Correspondence in file: Letter from Attorney William R. Doerr requesting the amendment to Section 9.26 of the zoning ordinance.

Attorney Doerr and Gordon Magee are present. Karl Jennrich, Zoning Director, stated that this request was brought forward by Attorney William Doerr, who is present today. Mr. Doerr's client is interested in purchasing a property that was used as a church but has been unoccupied for years. The property is currently zoned Business B-2 (District 7). The zoning ordinance does not include a church as a permitted use, administrative review use or conditional use in Section 9.26 Business B-1 and B-2 of the Oneida County Zoning and Shoreland Protection Ordinance. Mr. Jennrich noted that sometime between 2000 and 2001, this was omitted from the zoning ordinance. There are churches throughout the County located in areas zoned Business B-1 or B-2. Mr. Jennrich considers this to be a correction.

12:40 pm – Dave Hintz, Acting-Chairman, asked if there was any public comment for or against the issue at hand.

Attorney William Doerr spoke in favor of Ordinance Amendment #4-2011. Mr. Doerr stated that historically churches have been permitted in the business districts.

Gordon Magee spoke in favor of Ordinance Amendment #4-2011. Mr. Magee stated that it just makes sense. It will help to clean up the old and make room for the new.
