Truancy Ordinance Amendment

Chief Deputy, Dan Hess was present and distributed an ordinance amendment (Exhibit #1). Hess stated the change is to require a mandatory appearance instead of forfeiture. This will allow the judge to see the people and understand the family dynamic prior to setting the bail amount. Desmond noted the judge will generally set a forfeiture amount with a review date and he can adjust that amount based on school attendance.


