The following matters were taken up to wit:

- 1. Paszak called the meeting to order at 8:00 a.m. It was noted the meeting was properly posted and the media notified.
- 2. **Motion:** Cushing/Timmons to approve the agenda. Items may be taken out of order at the discretion of the Chairman. All ayes.

- 8. Bennett reported to the Committee that he spoke with the gravel crushing contractor and Oneida County received 20,139 tons of gravel but billed for 20,000 as per the contract. Holewinski feels the gravel piles should be measured after any subcontractor has crushed to make sure the tonnages are correct. Bennett is working with the Land Information Department and stated that the measuring should be done in early March.
- 9. Bennett informed the Committee that he has received notice from a contractor that wants to eliminate flaggers and instead use Private Portable Traffic Signals. Bennett expressed his concerns regarding this idea and the Committee agreed to not allow this on county roads.
- 10. Bennett reported that due to the extraordinary amount of rain in 2014 the fibercake ponds are higher than normal and have been found in non-compliance. Bennett stated work is already being done to correct this.
