- 1. Paszak called the meeting to order at 8:00 a.m. It was noted the meeting was properly posted and the media notified.
- 2. **Motion:** Cushing/Holewinski to approve the agenda. Items may be taken out of order at the discretion of the Chairman. All ayes.
- 3. **Motion:** Holewinski/Timmons to approve the minutes of the Public Works/Solids Waste meeting on June 25th, 2015. All ayes.
- 4. **Motion:** Cushing/Holewinski to approve Highway vendor vouchers # 381-445 for a total of \$790,874.60. All ayes.
