Questions on the board included the categories *The Way We Move* (how transportation issues relate to a sustainable lifestyle), *Resource Management, Safe Landing*, (how the land supports our activities by supplying us with space and resources-deforestation to cattle ranching) *Techies to the Rescue* (technology's ability to create or hinder a sustainable world), and *Keeping it All in Balance* (how humans are an essential part of an ecosystem, but can also destroy an ecosystem by exploiting its resources).

UPDATE ON VOLUNTEER APPRECIATION DAY: S. Schroeder reported that 37 people attended the volunteer appreciation day at the center where OCDOA staff served up strawberries, shortcake and whipped cream.
