Call to order:

Tom Rudolph called the meeting to order at 4:00 p.m., at the Nokomis Town Hall, Tomahawk, Wisconsin in accordance with the Wisconsin Open Meeting Law. Rudolph stated the proper media had been notified. Rudolph also stated for the record that notices were mailed to property owners listed by the Oneida Real Property/Tax Listing Department.

Discussion/decision to approve the agenda

Motion by Matt Matteson, second by Wilbur Petroskey to approve the Public Hearing agenda. With all "ayes", motion carried.

Motion by Matt Matteson, second by Jack Martinson to request the persons testifying to limit their testimony to three minutes. With all "ayes", motion carried.

Motion by Matt Matteson, second by Jack Martinson to request the letters filed with the County Clerk's office before the deadline be read into the record by Brian Desmond, Corporation Counsel after the oral testimony has been given. With all "ayes", motion carried.

Ken Dirks, Chairman for the Lake District Formation Committee and President Elect of the Lake Nokomis Concerned Citizens, read into record a letter explaining some of the Lake Nokomis property owners' views as to why they would like to see a Lake District formed. Mr. Dirks did not finish reading his letter because of the three minutes time limit.

Russell Wadzinski, President for the Lake Nokomis Concerned Citizens, finished reading Mr. Dirks letter into record.

David Nycz, Chairperson for the Weed Committee, stated he has been involved with Eurasian Water Milfoil in Lake Nokomis. He said he had received some donations to help with the costs. He commented that some progress has been made. Mr. Nycz reported Bridge Lake is heavily infested with Eurasian Water Milfoil and treating it could cost approximately \$25,000. He said a lake management plan for Bridge Lake is needed. Mr. Nycz closing statement was that the Eurasian Water Milfoil will spread if sufficient funding isn't available to address the problem.

Attorney Robert Shannon representing Don and Sam Scaffidi submitted a letter which serves as the Scaffidis' formal objection to inclusion of non-riparian property owned by them and located in the Township of Bradley within the proposed boundaries of the Lake Nokomis Inland Lake Protection and Rehabilitation District. Specifically the Scaffidis object to the

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boundaries proposed for the District and to determination that the lands owned by them will be benefitted by establishment of the proposed District. Attorney Shannon stated the law requires that an individualized determination be made that non-riparian property will be specifically benefitted by inclusion within the boundaries of a District. It appears however that the boundaries of this proposed District were established on the basis of convenient sectional or quarter – sectional lines within the township and not based on any determination that inclusion would result in specific benefit to the Scaffidi property.

Brian Desmond, attorney for Oneida County Corporation Counsel, went on record stating the Oneida County Clerk's Office had received 58 letters contained a total of 111 signatures. There were 110 signatures opposed and 1 signature in favor. Attorney Desmond stated the letters will be available for review at the Oneida County Land & Water Conservation Office located on the second floor of the Oneida County Courthouse.

Ms. Soward is opposed to a Lake District for the following reasons: Poor economy, escalating fuel prices, taxes are already too high, and the proposed boundaries are unfair.

❖ Michael Biels Speaker 7 opposed

Mr. Biels asked if a Lake District was really needed. He stated the Bradley dam wasn't included in the proposed boundaries. He would be in favor if it could be done without additional taxing.
