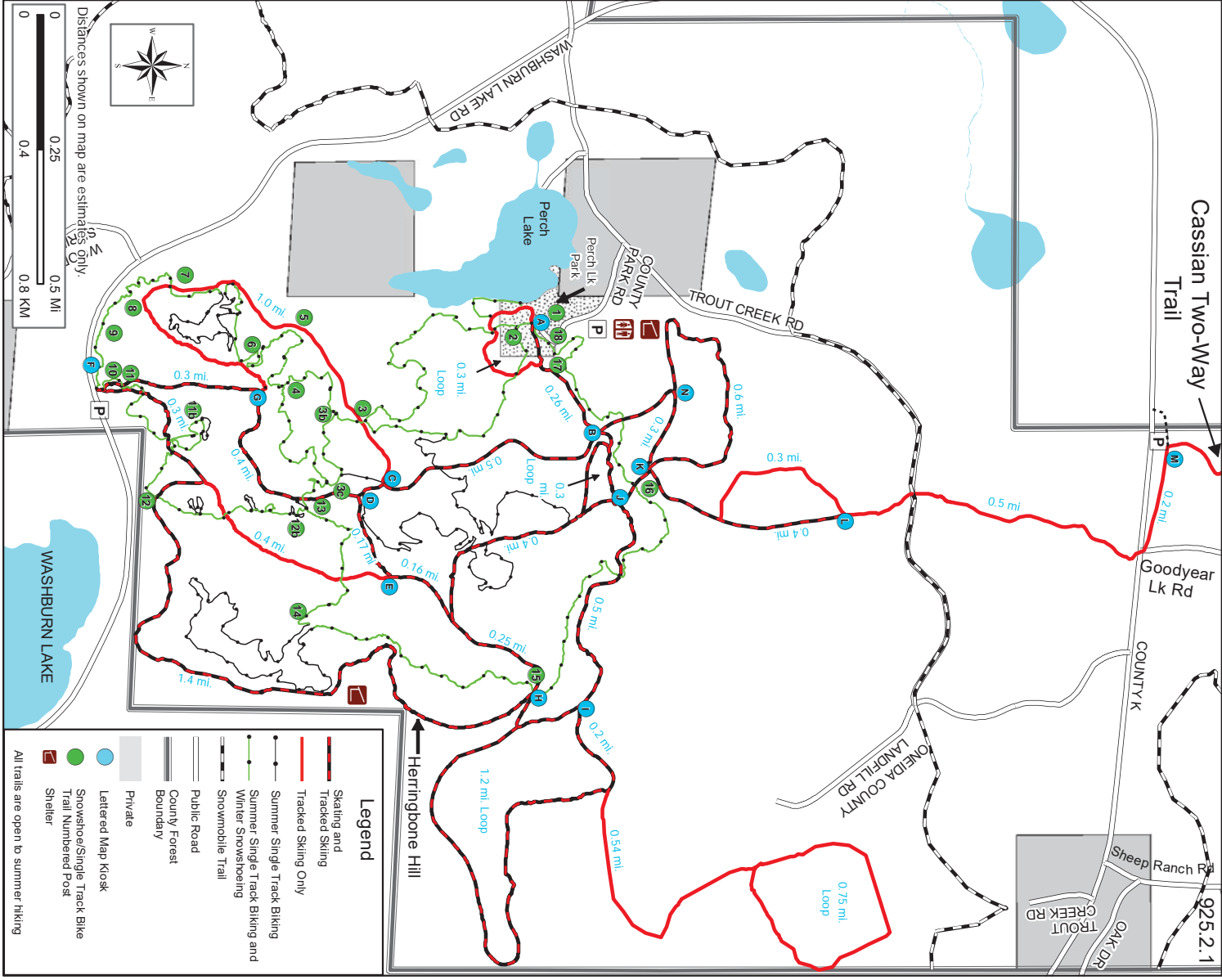
WASHBURN LAKE SILENT SPORTS TRAILS AREA

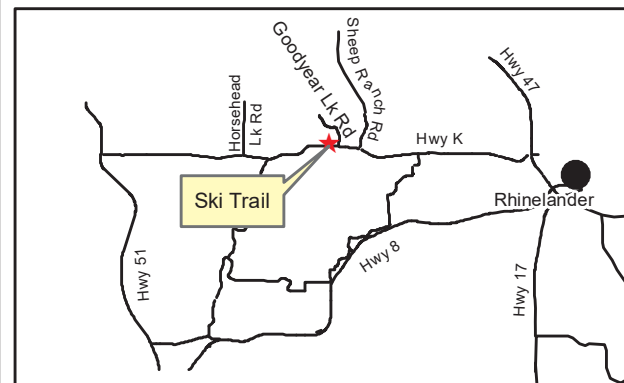
The Washburn Non-Motorized Trail System is located approximately 6 miles west of Rhinelander, WI. This trail system consists of approximately 12 miles (19 km) of groomed ski trail and 6 miles (10 km) of single track bike - snowshoe trail. There is a warming shelter with restrooms and parking located on County Park Rd. head on Washburn Lk Rd and at the north trail head on Hwy K. Use trails at your own risk. Trail conditions and routes may change without notice.
Perch Lake Park is open from 6:00 am to 10:00 pm daily. Please stay on trails and obey all directional signs.
No snowshoeing on ski trails.
No pets allowed on ski or snowshoe trails when said trails are snow covered.

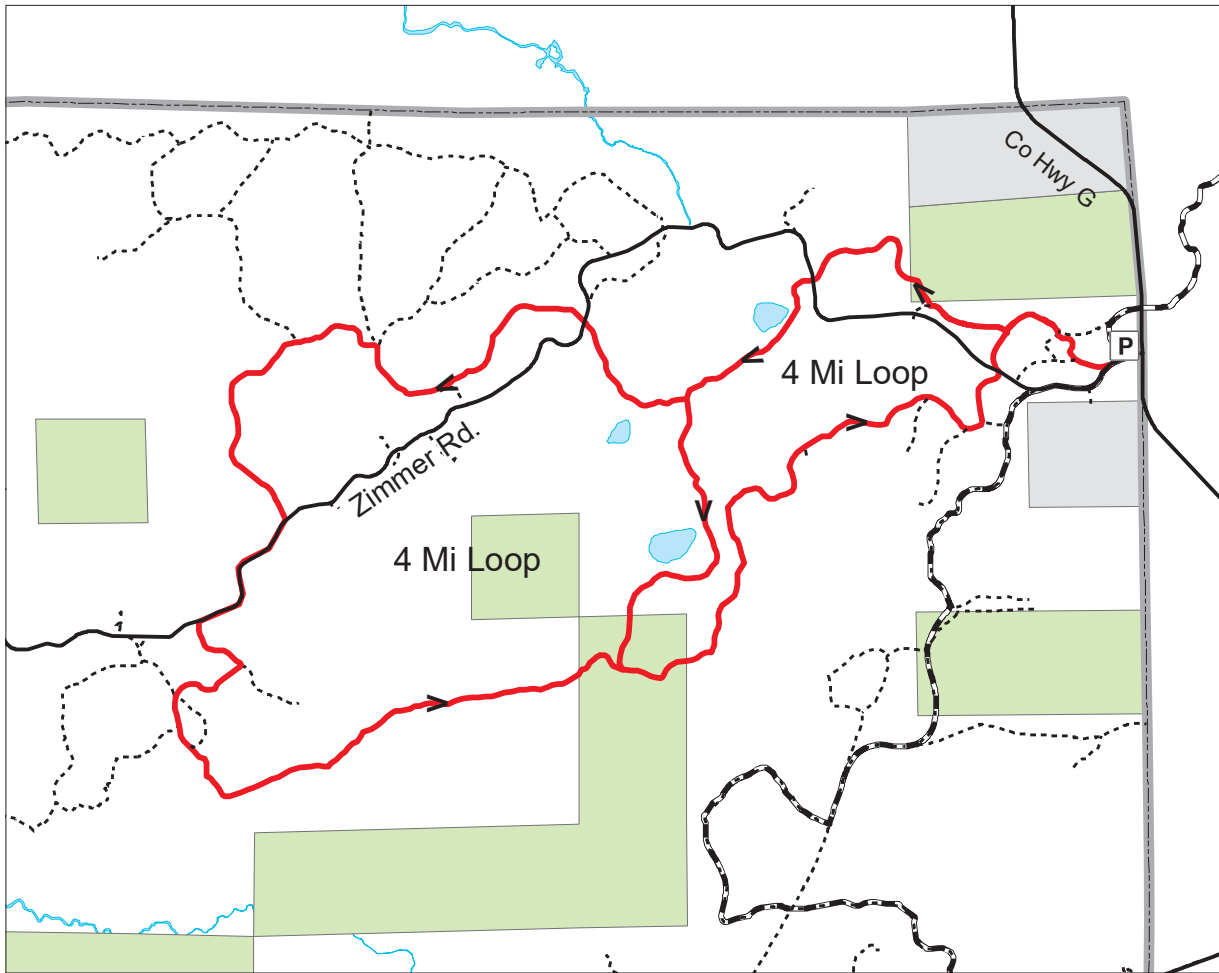


The Enterprise County Forest Winter Recreation Trail is located approximately 8 miles south of Hwy 8 on Co. Hwy G in Oneida County. The trail consists of two one-way loops that together equal approximately 8 miles.

Skill Level: Beginner to intermediate.

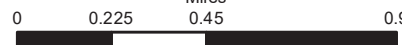

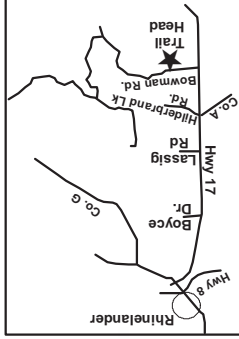

The Enterprise ATV Trail consists of 13 miles of trail and routes located entirely on Oneida County Forest. The trail links up with the Langlade County trails to the south and the Lincoln County trails to the west. A campground and picnic shelter are located in the central part of the trail system. Restrooms and water are available at the campground. Oneida County trails open on May 22 and close December 2. Please ride safely and obey all traffic signs. Be aware of changing trail conditions. **STAY ON THE TRAIL.**

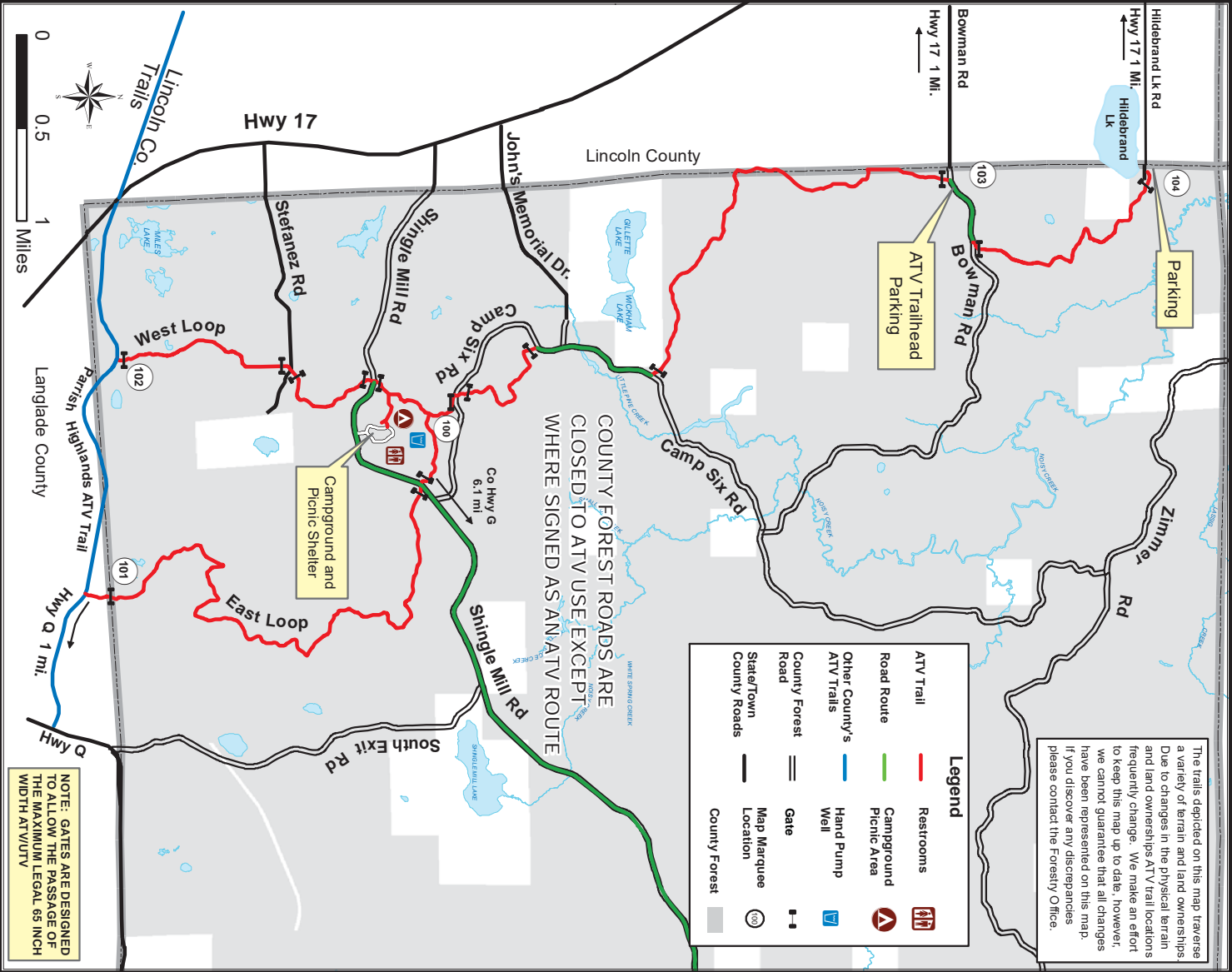

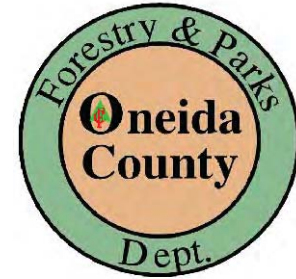

The Enterprise Campground is located within the Oneida County Forest approximately 11 miles south of Rhinelander on Shingle Mill Rd. The campground is accessible via the Enterprise ATV trail or via Shingle Mill Rd. There are 11 campsites with grills, fire rings and picnic tables. Restrooms and hand pump wells are also provided. The campground is open from May 22 until December 1.

A trail pass is required for all persons 18 years of age or older for snowshoeing or skiing on the nature trails. Trail passes are available at the trailhead map kiosk located in the east parking lot, and at the Forestry Office.

No pets are allowed on the beach or in picnic areas or public buildings. Pets are allowed in other parts of the park provided they are leashed.

No glass allowed in the park.

The use of Bicycles and Motorcycles is limited to the asphalt parking lots and roadways. No bicycles or motorcycles are allowed on beach or in picnic areas.

No fires allowed except in picnic grills for the purpose of cooking.

Restrooms are open May 15 through October 31.

A full set of regulations is posted on the sign board near the parking lot. Refer to Ch. 14 of the Oneida County code for full regulations.

The park is open from 6:00 a.m. until 10:00 p.m.

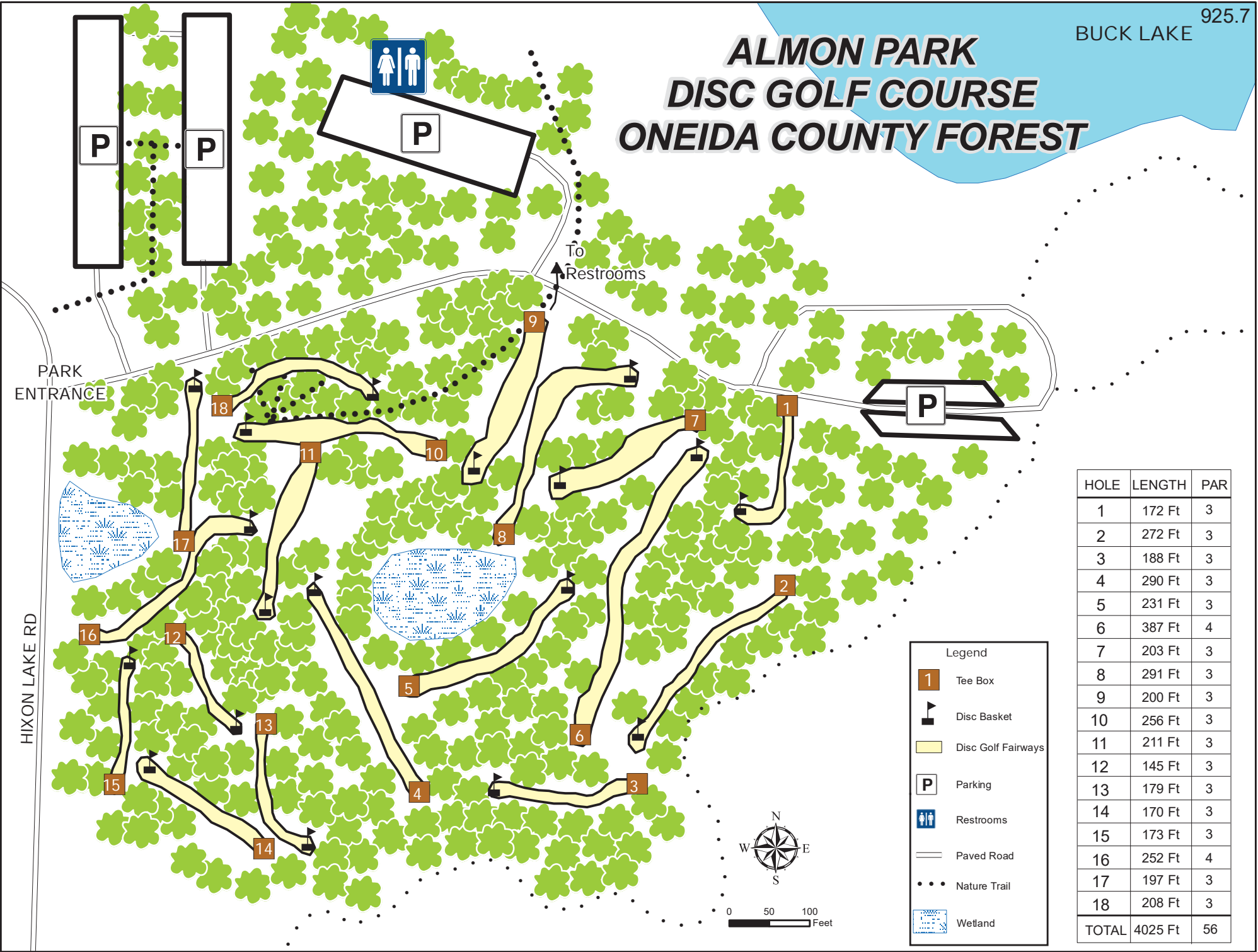

Almon Park is located approximately 5 miles south of Rhinelander on Buck Lake. This 160 acre park consists of a swimming beach, picnic areas and shelters, nature trails and a disc golf course. Restrooms are located near the beach and at the Rudolph Shelter. Changing rooms are also located at the beach. The Rudolph Shelter may be reserved for private functions after Memorial Day through Labor Day (excluding Holidays). Contact the Forestry Department for rental information. The nature trails are open for hiking, skiing and snowshoeing.
