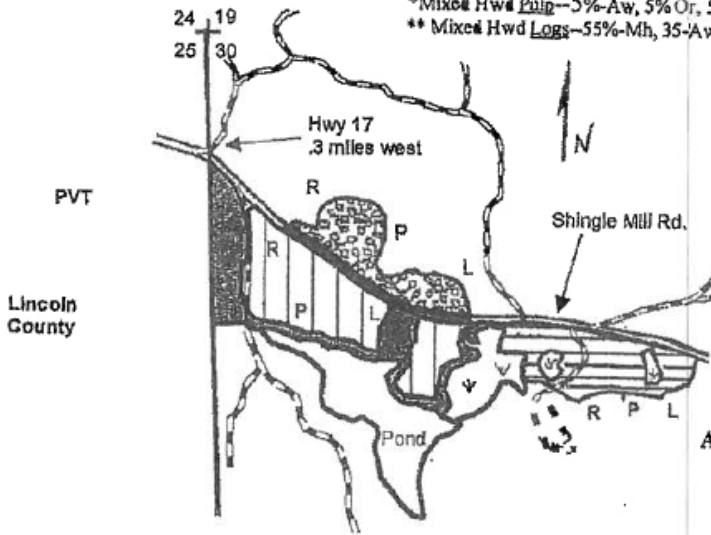

Additional Regulations

- A. Logging operations are restricted to the dates from July 15 through the following Spring Break Up, ~March 15 and only when the ground is dry enough or frozen to prevent rutting. Following oak wilt restrictions. If rutting occurs, additional regulations will be implemented.

Firewood Harvest Regulations:

Do not cut standing trees, dead or not.

Harvest firewood only from tops and branches of logging debris.

All roads and trails are to be kept free from branches and debris.
