


A trail pass is required for all persons 18 years of age or older for snowshoeing or skiing on the nature trails. Trail passes are available at the trailhead map kiosk located in the east parking lot and at the Forestry Office. No pets are allowed on the beach, in picnic areas or public buildings. Pets are allowed in other parts of the park provided they are leashed. Please clean up after your pet.

The use of bicycles and motorcycles is limited to the asphalt parking lots and roadways. No bicycles or motorcycles are allowed on beach or in picnic areas.

NO GLASS ALLOWED IN PARK. No fires allowed except in picnic grills for the purpose of cooking. Restrooms are open from May15th through October 31st.

A full set of regulations is posted on the sign board near the parking lot. Refer to Ch. 14 of the Oneida County Code for all regulations. **The park is open from 6:00 am to 10:00 pm.** 



Rhinelander on Buck Lake. This 160 acre park consists of a swimming beach, picnic areas and shelters, nature trails and an 18 hole disc golf course. Restrooms are located near the beach and at the Rudoph Shelter. Changing rooms are also located at the beach. The Rudolph Shelter may be reserved for private functions. Contact the Forestry Department for rental information. The nature trails are open for hiking, skiing and snowshoeing.
