











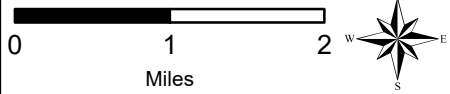
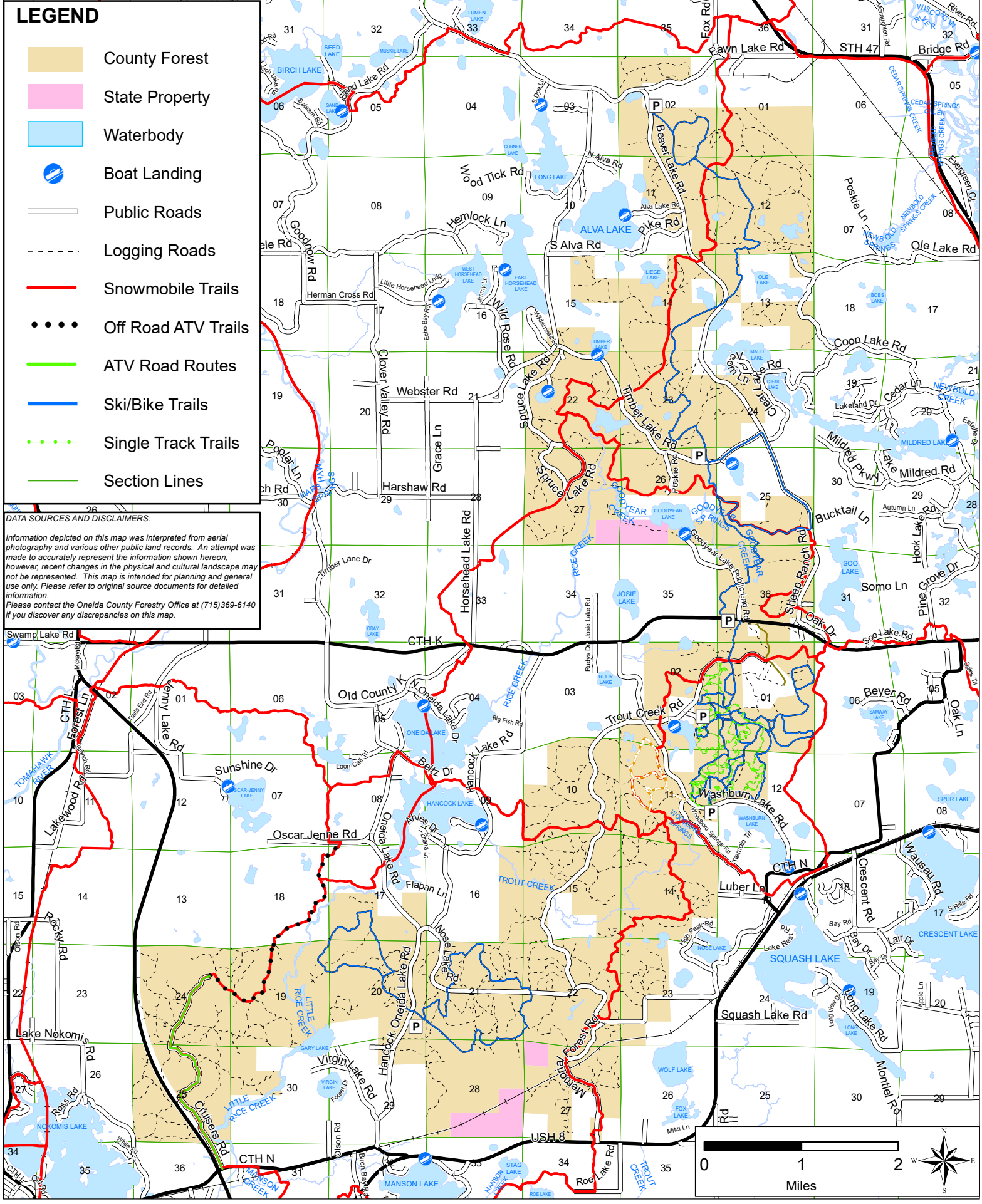

The Cassian/Woodboro block of the Oneida County Forest is located in the south-central part of the County. This block consists of approximately 15,000 acres. Aspen, hardwood, oak and pine are the predominant forest types.

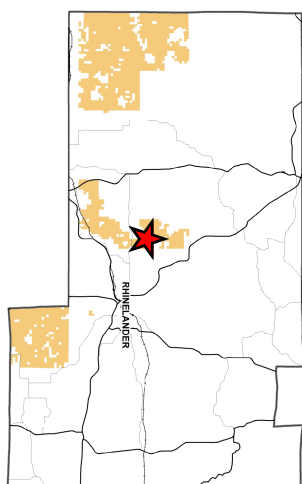
The topography of this area ranges from level to quite steep. Ridges and ravines are numerous in the central part of this block. A few small creeks, including Trout Creek, and small ponds are found throughout the area.

The Washburn Silent Trails Area, Cassian Ski/Bike Trail, Nose Lake Ski/Bike Trail and Perch Lake Park are located in this block.

Many game and non-game wildlife species are common in the area. Among these are deer, grouse, bear, osprey and eagles.

Active forest management has created a variety of cover types that support wildlife along with providing access to the forest.
