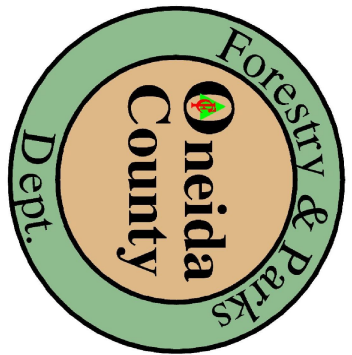
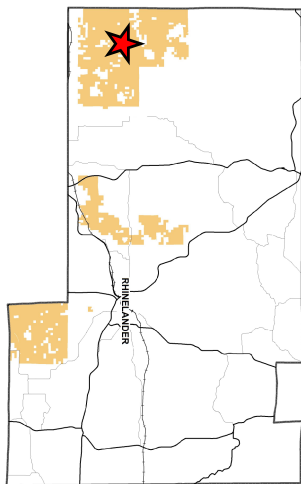


**LYNNE/LITTLE RICE BLOCK

The Lynne/Little Rice block of the Oneida County Forest is located in the western part of the County. This block consists of approximately 47,000 acres. Large sections of unbroken forest can be found here. Aspen, hardwood, pine, spruce, cedar and balsam fir are the predominant forest types.

The topography of the area is generally level with numerous swamps, marshes and wetlands. Many small streams, creeks and rivers traverse this area, some of which are classified as trout streams. Several lakes along with the Willow Flowage are also located in the area.

Many game and non-game wildlife species are common in the area. Among these are deer, wolves, grouse, eagles and bears.

Active forest management has created a variety of cover types that support wildlife along with providing access to the forest.
