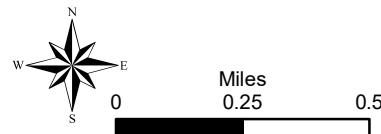

Dogs are allowed on the ski-bike and snowshoe trails, but must be kept under the owner's control at all times. Please clean up after your pet.

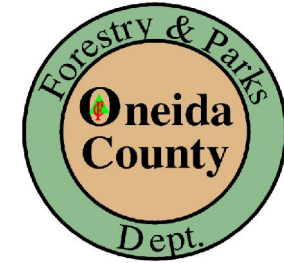
Parking is available in the lot located off Hancock Oneida Lake Road. Please do not park on the town road.

A portable restroom is located at the parking lot.

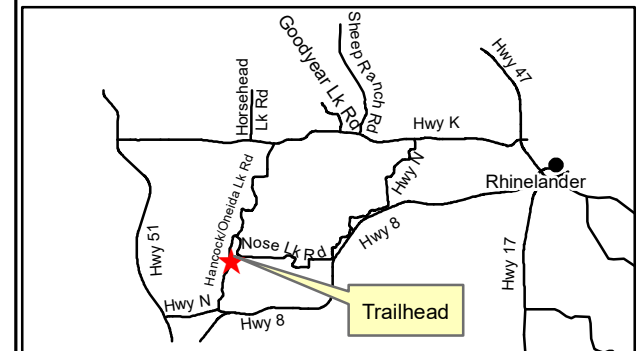

The Nose Lake Ski-Bike Trail is located 12 miles west of Rhineland between Hwy K and Hwy 8 in Oneida County. The trail has two main loops: the east loop is 4.7 miles long and the west loop is 2.6 miles long with a 0.7 mile connector trail between the two loops. The trail is open for biking during non-ski season. There is two way traffic so please stay to the right.

Skill Level: Beginner to Intermediate. Trail is groomed for tracked skiing.

There are two snowshoe trail loops west of Hancock Oneida Lake Rd. The south loop is 1.2 miles and the north loop is 0.9 miles with a 0.2 mile connector.

Please stay on trails and obey all directional signs.
No snowshoeing on ski trails.
All trails are open to biking and hiking during non-ski season.

A trail pass is required for all persons 18 years of age or older.

Trail passes are available at all trail heads or from the Oneida County Forestry Office. 06/23
