11 Resolved by the Board of Supervisors of Oneida County, Wisconsin:

14 WHEREAS, the Planning & Development Committee, having considered
15 Ordinance Amendment #07-2023, which was filed August 14, 2023 (copy attached) to
16 amend Section 9.53 of the Oneida County Zoning and Shoreland Protection Ordinance,
17 and having given notice thereof as provided by law and having held a public hearing
18 thereon September 20, 2023, pursuant to Section 59.69(5), Wisconsin Statutes, and
19 having been informed of the facts pertinent to the changes which are as follows:
20

21 WHEREAS, the Towns of Little Rice and Nokomis have requested for Oneida
22 County to impose a moratorium on campgrounds and recreational parks; and
23

24 WHEREAS, the Town of Nokomis has seen an influx of campground and
25 recreational vehicle park conditional use permits; and
26

27 WHEREAS, a moratorium would allow the Planning and Development
28 Committee to review Section 9.53 Campgrounds and Recreational Vehicle Park
29 provisions as well as the zoning districts that allow campground and recreational vehicle
30 parks; and

32 WHEREAS, the Planning and Development Committee held a public hearing and
33 people spoke both in favor and in opposition of the proposed changes; and

35 WHEREAS, the Planning and Development Committee has carefully studied the
36 proposed changes after listening to comments made at the public hearing and
37 recommends approval.

39 NOW, THEREFORE, THE ONEIDA COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
40 DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

41 Section 1. Any existing ordinances, codes, resolutions, or portions thereof in
42 conflict with this ordinance shall be and hereby are repealed as far as any conflict exists.

43 Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect the day after passage and publication
44 as required by law.

45 Section 3. If any claims, provisions or portions of this ordinance are adjudged
46 unconstitutional or invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this
47 ordinance shall not be affected thereby.

48 Section 4. Chapter 9 of the General Code of Oneida County, Wisconsin, is
49 amended as follows [additions noted by underline, deletions noted by strikethrough]:

Section 9.53 remains the same except:

9.53 CAMPGROUNDS AND RECREATIONAL VEHICLE PARKS

I. Conditional Use Permits for Campgrounds and Recreational Vehicle Parks as defined in Article 10 of the Oneida County Zoning and Shoreland Protection Ordinance shall not be issued for a period of 180 days after the adoption and publication by the Oneida County Board of Supervisors. (Insert date of publication.)

The County Clerk shall, within seven (7) days after adoption of Ordinance Amendment #07-2023 by the Oneida County Board of Supervisors, cause a certified copy thereof to be transmitted by mail to the Town Clerks of Oneida County and the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources.




