Upon payment of the investigation fee, this application will be immediately turned over to the Sheriff's Department for investigation. The approval or disapproval of issuance of a permit will be determined within 96 hours. If approved, such permit shall be issued by the Sheriff's Department. No fees will be refunded if the application is denied.

NOTICE TO PERMIT HOLDER

This permit has been issued in accordance with Section 12.05 General Code of Oneida County, Wisconsin. No person shall alter or change this permit in any manner, and shall display the same in a conspicuous place on the premises or exhibit the same upon demand by any person. All orders taken by the permit holder who accepts payment or deposit of money in advance of final delivery, shall be in writing, in duplicate, stating the terms thereof and the amount paid in advance and one copy shall be given to the purchaser at the time the deposit of money is paid.

Permit holder shall not falsely or fraudulently misrepresent the quantity, character or quality of any article offered for sale, nor intentionally misrepresent to any prospective customer the purpose of their visit or solicitation nor the name of the business or his/her principal, if any, nor the source of the supply of the goods, ware or merchandise he or she sells or offers for sale nor the disposition of the proceeds or profits of his or her sales.
