<u>Call to order:</u> Chairman Kelly called the meeting to order at 9:10 a.m. on the second floor of the Health & ADRC Building, 100 W. Keenan Street, Rhinelander, WI. The meeting was posted in accordance with the Wisconsin Open Meeting Law and the facility is handicap accessible.

Minutes of April 12, 2022: Motion by Zietlow/Slette to approve the April 12, 2022, Board of Health Committee minutes. All ayes; motion carried.

Approval of agenda: Motion by Zietlow/Slette to approve today's agenda with the order of items at the Chair's discretion to move around. All ayes; motion carried.

Welcome New Committee Member: Postponed

Election of Vice-Chair: Motion by Zietlow/Kelly to appoint Billy Fried as Vice Chair of the Board of Health Committee. All ayes; motion carried.

<u>Introduction of new staff member:</u> Conlon introduced new staff member, Katherine Unruh, who is the new account tech with finance.

<u>Staff Report – Breanne Voss:</u> Vos presented a handout and reviewed the car seat program at the Oneida County Health Department (OCHD).

Vos said the Oneida County Health Department receives a grant from the Department of Transportation to provide free car seats to families in need. She mentioned there are two certified Child Passenger Safety Technicians (CPST) at OCHD department that can provide education and car seat assistance. One of the OCHD CPST also received training in fitting and installing specialized car seats for children with special health care

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needs. OCHD also puts on free car seat events for the community to have car seats checked and provide free car seats to qualifying families.

Out of State Travel Request: Conlon reviewed conference request for Moore to go to the National Conference on Tobacco or Health in New Orleans, LA. Conlon stated this conference is fully grant funded. Motion made by Kelly/Slette to approve the Out of Sate Travel Request.

<u>First Quarter 2022 Work Comp Report:</u> Conlon said the health department still has one open claim from 2020 when the Dodge Caravan was totaled. Conlon reviewed the claim and stated she will check with LRES on why the claim is still open.
