Staff Report - Jennifer Chiamulera and Mary Rideout:

<u>Criminal Justice Coordinative Committee (CJCC)</u>: Mary Rideout from Social Services gave background on the Criminal Justice Coordinative Committee (CJCC), which they are looking to establish in Oneida County. Rideout explained what the committee would do and how it could benefit the community.
