Resolution to establish compensation for Oneida County Clerk of Courts for 2027 – 2030.

Hartman explained that the resolution brought forward brings the wage up to the level that was previously approved for the County Clerk, Register of Deeds and Treasurer. This will put the position on the wage schedule at grade O. Motion by Jensen to approve the Resolution to establish compensation for Oneida County Clerk of Courts for 2027 – 2030. Seconded by Hess. Fried expressed that he is fundamentally against the resolution and feels that tying it to the wage schedule could present concerns in the future. Fried stated that he will not be supporting the resolution. Discussion regarding what a fair number would be and how that would be determined. Holewinski expressed support for this resolution. 5 ayes; 1 nay; 1 absent, Showalter, motion carried.

Resolution to establish compensation for Oneida County Sheriff for 2027 – 2030. Hartman explained that this is the same resolution that was brought forward and passed 4 years ago with only changes to the years and committee names. Discussion regarding how the wage was determined. Motion by Hess to approve the Resolution to establish compensation for Oneida County Sheriff for 2027 – 2030. Seconded by Schreier. 6 ayes; 0 nays; 1 absent, Showalter, motion carried.
