

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN the Oneida County Board of Adjustment will hold a public hearing on Thursday, May 7, 2026, 9:30 a.m., Committee Room #1, 2nd Floor, Oneida County Courthouse, Rhinelander, WI 54501, to consider the appeal described herein. The appellant must be present or represented. Wisconsin Open Meetings Law will govern.

Appeal No. 2600087 of Pine Harbor Beach Bar & Grill LLC a/k/a Pine Harbor Properties LLC, owner, and Kirk Ecklund, agent, appealing the administrative revocation of tourist rooming house permits #2301235, #2400353, and #2400364. The property is located at 3997 Trails End Rd and 3983 & 3985 Harbor Rd, further described as being part of Government Lot 5, Section 36, T37N, R8E, PIN PL-160-36, Town of Pine Lake.

Chapter 17, Board of Adjustment, Section 17.05(12) provides that a timely appeal shall stay all proceedings and furtherance of the action appealed from, unless the officer from whom the appeal is taken shall certify to the board, after the notice of appeal shall have been filed with said officer that by reason of facts stated in the certificate a stay would cause imminent peril to life or property.

Following adjournment of the public hearing, the board will vote in open session for a decision on this appeal. Interested parties may obtain information regarding the decision by calling or visiting the Planning & Zoning Office during regular business hours following the appeal decision, or at a later day set by the board during the hearing. The appellant will be notified of the decision via certified mail.

All written comments will be given to board members prior to the start of the public hearing and announced by name during the public hearing. Written comments may not be read into the record (Chairman's discretion).
