

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN the Oneida County Board of Adjustment will hold a public hearing on Thursday, September 3, 2026, 10:00 a.m., Board Room, 3rd Floor, Minocqua Center, 415 Menominee Street, Minocqua, WI 54548, to consider the appeal described herein. The appellant must be present or represented. Wisconsin Open Meetings Law will govern.

Appeal No. 2600627 of BHMQ LLC, owner, and Attorney Timothy Melms, agent, appealing the denial of zoning permit #2600503 for expansion of a non-conforming structure within the setback. The property is located at 305 W Park Ave, further described as being part of Government Lot 5, Section 14, T39N, R6E, PIN MI 2206-13, Town of Minocqua.

Chapter 17, Board of Adjustment, Section 17.05(12) provides that a timely appeal shall stay all proceedings and furtherance of the action appealed from, unless the officer from whom the appeal is taken shall certify to the board, after the notice of appeal shall have been filed with said officer that by reason of facts stated in the certificate a stay would cause imminent peril to life or property.

The Board of Adjustment will meet at the above-described property beginning at approximately 9:00 a.m. prior to the hearing. Pertinent property boundaries and locations of existing and proposed structures shall be clearly identified. Proposed structures shall be marked with stakes, flags, ribbons, etc., as accurately as possible. A representative or the appellant must be present. The inspection shall be open to the public.

Following adjournment of the public hearing, the board will vote in open session for a decision on this appeal. Interested parties may obtain information regarding the decision by calling or visiting the Planning & Zoning Office during regular business hours following the appeal decision, or at a later day set by the board during the hearing. The appellant will be notified of the decision via certified mail.

Anyone having interest may attend and be heard. Interested parties who are unable to attend may send written comments to the undersigned prior to the hearing. All written comments shall include your name and voting address and, if not from Oneida County, your property address within Oneida County. All written comments will be given to board members prior to the start of the public hearing and announced by name during the public hearing. Written comments may not be read into the record (Chairman's discretion).
