Ms. Mary Rideout explained that we requested \$125,000 for 2024. This is just the pre-application. The full application will need to be done. Will bring it to the October CJCC Meeting.

**7. CJCC Website Update:**

Public Safety approved the use of ARPA dollars for the website but we can use the grant money. The CJCC Website will be part of the County's Website. A check was cut to the Web Developer. Hopefully will have it ready for viewing at the October meeting.

**8. GAP Analysis:**

Ms. Niki Leicht, Mr. Jamie Kiener, Mr. Nick Sayner from Justice Point lead the group in the GAP Analysis. The group was asked what are big ideas or dreams. What are opportunities in the system where things could change to improve the system. Some items discussed were:

- Services need to be provided soon after arrest. Get moving quicker.
- Lack of private bar attorneys.
- People are booked and released. It could be weeks before they are seen.
- Assessments being completed and connected to services. Knowing if it is completed and what are the recommended needs and treatment.
- Information sharing between people. Is there something in place between HSC and Law Enforcement?
- Treatment Court
- Sober Housing (transitional housing)
- GAP between free/low cost attorney and paying for attorney
- Crisis system – screener called – need in person mobile/crisis teams
- Utilizing evidence based interventions/services, what have others done that we can look at to see if it would work in Oneida County.

Justice Point will summarize the information and will be addressed in the sub-committee.

**9. Budget and Program Reports:**


