1. Call to Order:

6. Treatment Alternative and Diversion Program (TAD) Grant Update and Budget:

Ms. Mary Rideout reported that the TAD Grant Sub-committee has held two meetings and hopefully will have a draft Policy and Procedure Manual to the CJCC in May.

The first quarter report was submitted to the committee.

There is a conference on April 26, 2023 – Opioid Use Disorder: Medications and Beyond and Graduate Panel that has Zoom availability if anyone is interested in attending. Will need to know by Friday if you are interested in attending.

7. Opioid Settlement Funds – Proposal to utilize some of these funds to hire/contract for a Substance Abuse Counselor for TAD Grant and OWI Court:

Ms. Mary Rideout discussed that there is a limited amount of service providers which is a barrier as it takes too long to get people seen. To be successful we can't wait to have people seen. People could go 3-6 months before an assessment which is needed before they go into a treatment program. Would like to look at the possibility of hiring/contracting with someone dedicated to Oneida County. Is this worth looking into? The committee felt this would be worth exploring the options. A provider would need to be in place if we ever wanted to do a Treatment Court. The committee would like an update at each meeting as to the status of this.


